Re: Transition to Hybrid Learning for Grades 7-12

As announced by Lake County Public Health on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, Lake County has met the criteria to now be considered in the Red Tier with a case rate of 5.2/100,000. This is very exciting news since this allows Lakeport Unified School District to welcome students in grades 7-12 back to campus for in-person instruction.

Per previous site-level communication, students in grades 7-12 are now able to begin Hybrid Learning schedules on Monday, March 22, 2021. Each school will share site-specific information and notify you of your child's schedule.

The health and safety of staff and students remain a top priority, so all required protocols will remain in place throughout the District, including mask-wearing, social-distancing expectations where appropriate, and temperature checks for students upon arrival to school. Regular cleaning and disinfecting schedules will continue as a means to support the sanitization of shared spaces.
