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CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS: Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible

ENTER/EXIT:

- Have all materials needed from backpack, line up along ramp unitl invited in, enter quietly and safely, get prepared for class.
- Push in chairs anytime you stand, exit with permission only, and walk safely and quietly.
- Ask permission, pay ticket, sign out, and wear pass to use bathroom during class time
- Ask permission and pay ticket to retrieve something left in backpack
- Line up along ramp to walk as a class.

MATERIALS:

- Students are expected to have all needed materials for school everyday, including pencils, binders with color subject files, and notebooks, in accordance with the Supply List
- Pencils should be sharpened before class; barrel sharpeners at desk are OK; electric sharpeners in class are to be used during seat work (not instruction)
- Students unable to supply their own materials can ask the teacher assistance

HOMEWORK:

- Students should expect some homework Monday-Thursday that is due the following day, along with occasional projects.
- Students are responsible for finding out and completing work from days they were absent, and are given an extra day to complete this.
- It tends to work best when students set up a routine of **time and place** to complete homework
- Can attend **PASS** after school on Tues., Wed., and Thurs.2;25-3:15pm for homework help, and may be able to get help before school
- Homework generally includes approximately 20 minutes of Reading, and 20 minutes of Math, along with Spelling/Grammar practice. If a student has attempted the work and finds it too difficult, parents can write a note in Agenda
- LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER is open 7:30am-4:00 pm for students

AGENDAS:

- Should be checked and signed each day by parents/guardians
- Can be used as a communication tool with teacher/school
- Handbook of school expectations, policies, schedules, etc.

FOOD/DRINK:

- Fresh fruits, vegetables, and water are allowed in class, so long as they don't disrupt education and are not shared with other students.
- No food or drinks on desks when using computers
- Morning Nutritional Break 9:45-10:00 am is the only time food is allowed outside

MERITS:

- Students can earn or lose merits in our school-wide program by demonstrating (or violating) our basic policies of Being Safe, Being Respectful, and Being Responsible.
- Students may be given opportunities to earn merit points.

PRIDE:

Terrace encourages and supports positive character traits: *Perseverance, Respect, Integrity, Discovery, and Empathy*. Students can earn merits and badges by demonstrating these traits.

VISITS: If visiting the classroom or dropping something off, please check in at the main office and wear a visitor badge. This helps us ensure the safety of all students.
